2. The Grand Jury of said County further charge that before the finding of this indictment JAMES BINFORD, whose name is to the Grand Jury otherwise unknown, unlawfully distilled, made or manufactured alcoholic or spirituous liquor, to-wit, whiskey, a part of which was alcohol,

against the peace and dignity of the State of Alabama.
