The Grand Jury of said County charge that before the finding of this indictment JOHNNY HAYES, whose name is to the Grand Jury otherwise unknown, with intent to steal, broke into and entered the Robertsdale High School building, a building of the State of Alabama, in which goods, wares, merchandise, or candies, things of value, were kept for use, sale or deposit, against the peace and dignity of the State of Alabama.

2. The Grand Jury of said County further charge that before the finding of this indictment JOHNNY HAYES, whose name is to the Grand Jury otherwise unknown, feloniously took and carried away from the Robertsdale High School house, to-wit, thirty boxes of candy, of the value of, to-wit, thirty dollars, the personal property of the Baldwin County Board of Education, in the custody of C. F. Taylor,

against the peace and dignity of the State of Alabama.
