2. The Grand Jury of said County further charge that before the finding of this indictment FRANKLIN HAYES, whose name is to the Grand Jury otherwise unknown, feloniously took and carried away from the Loxley Junior High School house, towit, money in about the amount of six dollars, in lawful United States coin money, a further description of the amount and denominations of which is unknown to the Grand Jury, of the value of, to-wit, six dollars, and two stop watches, of the value of, to-wit, twenty-four dollars, the said money and stop watches being the personal property of the Baldwin County Board of Education, in the custody of Samuel Gates,

against the peace and dignity of the State of Alabama.
