F. Henderson, in which goods, wares, merchandise, or watches, things of value, were kept for use, sale or deposit, against the peace and dignity of the State of Alabama.

2. The Grand Jury of said county further charge that before the finding of this indictment THOMAS EDWARD KITTRELL, whose name is to the Grand Jury otherwise unknown, feloniously took and carried away, to-wit, one Landon watch, of the value of, to-wit, twenty-seven and 50/100 (\$27.50) dollars, one Bulova watch, of the value of, to-wit, forty dollars, one Baby Ben alarm clock, of the value of, to-wit, seven dollars, and lawful United States silver coin in denominations of half-dollars and quarter-dollars, the number of each of said coin being unknown to the Grand Jury, of the value of, to-wit, three dollars, the said watches, clock and coin all being the personal property of C. F. Henderson,

against the peace and dignity of the State of Alabama.
