The Grand Jury of said County further charge that before the finding of this indictment ARTHUR ANDERSON, whose name is to the Grand Jury otherwise unknown, did buy, receive, conceal, or aid in concealing two batteries, of the value of, to-wit, thirty-six dollars, the personal property of the State of Alabama, knowing that they were stolen, and not having the intent to restore them to the owner, against the peace and dignity of the State of Alabama.
- 4. The Grand Jury of said County further charge that before the finding of this indictment ARTHUR ANDERSON, whose name is to the Grand Jury otherwise unknown, did buy, receive, conceal, or aid in concealing two batteries, of the value of, to-wit, thirty-six dollars, the personal property of the State of Alabama, having reasonable grounds for believing they were stolen, and not having the intent to restore them to the owner, against the peace and dignity of the State of Alabama.
- 5. The Grand Jury of said County further charge that before the finding of this indictment ARTHUR ANDERSON, whose name is to the Grand Jury otherwise unknown, did buy or receive two batteries, of the value of, to-wit, thirty-six dollars, the personal property of the State of Alabama, knowing that they had been embezzled or xagainstyle peace and xdignity of xhex State of Alabama.
