INDICTMENT

THE STATE OF ALABAMA }
Baldwin County. }

Circuit Court. Spring Session, 1953

The Grand Jury of said County charge that before the finding of this indictment ARTHUR ANDERSON, whose name is to the Grand Jury otherwise unknown, being charged or intrusted with the receipt of two batteries, of the value of, to-wit, thirty-six dollars, the said batteries being personal property belonging to or under the control of the State of Alabama or of N. B. Breswell, an officer of the State of Alabama, did unlawfully convert to his own use, or to the use of another, or did embezzle, the said two batteries, of the value of, to-wit, thirty-six dollars, the property of the State of Alabama, against the peace and dignity of the State of Alabama.

2. The Grand Jury of said County further charge that before the finding of this indictment ARTHUR ANDERSON, whose name is to the Grand Jury otherwise unknown, feloniously took and carried away two batteries, of the value of, to-wit, thirty-six dollars, the personal property of the State of Alabama, against the peace and dignity of the State of Alabama.

3. The Grand Jury of said County further charge that before the finding of this indictment ARTHUR ANDERSON, whose name is to the Grand Jury otherwise unknown, did buy, receive, conceal, or aid in concealing two batteries, of the value of, to-wit, thirty-six dollars, the personal property of the State of Alabama, knowing that they were stolen, and not having the intent to restore them to the owner, against the peace and dignity of the State of Alabama.

4. The Grand Jury of said County further charge that before the finding of this indictment ARTHUR ANDERSON, whose name is to the Grand Jury otherwise unknown, did buy, receive, conceal, or aid in concealing two batteries, of the value of, to-wit, thirty-six dollars, the personal property of the State of Alabama, having reasonable grounds for believing they were stolen, and not having the intent to restore them to the owner, against the peace and dignity of the State of Alabama.

5. The Grand Jury of said County further charge that before the finding of this indictment ARTHUR ANDERSON, whose name is to the Grand Jury otherwise unknown, did buy or receive two batteries, of the value of, to-wit, thirty-six dollars, the personal property of the State of Alabama, knowing that they had been embezzled or fraudulently converted, or fraudulently secreted with intent to prevent the recovery thereof, or to defraud the rightful owner, against the peace and dignity of the State of Alabama.
