The plaintiff claims of the defendant the sum of Twenty-five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000.00) as damages for that heretofore on, towit, the 6th day of July, 1950, the plaintiff was operating an automobile along and upon a public highway in Baldwin County, Alabama, on, to-wit, Alabama Highway Noo 104, approximately 1.2 miles north of the intersection of said Highway with Highway No. 89, where he had a right to be, and while said automobile was being operated by him at said time and place, an automobile which was then and there being operated by the defendant ran upon, over or against the automobile of the plaintiff, causing great damages and injuries to the plaintiff, as follows: Plaintiff's automobile was broken, bent, smashed or otherwise damaged and injured and plaintiff's body was bruised, mutilated, and injured; he was bruised and injured in his face, head and other parts of his body; he suffered the loss of his left arm above the elbow; was made sick and sore; has suffered and is suffering excrutiating exemptizing/mental pain and anguish, and will be partially disabiled and incapacitated for the remainder of his life. The plaintiff alleges that all of his said damages were proximately caused by the negligence of the defendant, in that he negligently caused, allowed or permitted the automobile being operated by him to run upon, over or against the automobile of the plaintiff and as a proximate consequence thereof, the plaintiff was damaged and injured as aforesaid.
