Figure 1. The effect of the concentration of the *Agrobacterium* suspension on the transformation efficiency of *Agrobacterium* strains. The *Agrobacterium* strains were cultured in the YEA medium for 24 h at 28 °C. The cell concentration of the strains was adjusted to 10⁸ cells/ml. The cell suspension was mixed with the plant tissue and the mixture was incubated for 24 h at 28 °C. The plant tissue was then cultured on the selective medium for 2 weeks. The transformation efficiency was calculated as the number of transformants per 100 mg of plant tissue. The data are the mean ± SD of three independent experiments.
