
Your petitioner, SYBRIL S. KEITH, respectfully represents

"Exhibit A".


That at the time of the granting of said decree, your

This cause, coming on to be heard at this Term, was submitted upon the Bill of Complaint, decree pro confesso and the testimony as noted by the Register; and upon consideration thereof, the Court is of opinion that the Complainant is entitled to the relief prayed for in said bill.

IT IS, THEREFORE, Ordered, adjudged and decreed by the Court, that the bonds of matrimony heretofore existing between the Complainant and Defendant be, and the same are hereby dissolved, and the complainant is forever divorced from the Defendant, on account of Adultery.

It is further ordered, that the said James E. Keith, Jr., be, and he is hereby permitted to again contract marriage, upon the payment of the costs of the Court in this cause.

It is further ordered, that the said James E. Keith, Jr., pay the costs herein taxed, for which execution may issue, and if such execution is returned "no property found," then execution for such costs may issue against the said Sybul S. Keith.

It is further ordered, adjudged and decreed that the said James E. Keith, Jr., shall not again marry except to said Sybul S. Keith until sixty days after this date, and that if an appeal is taken within sixty days he shall not marry again except to said Sybul S. Keith, during the said pendency of appeal.

It is further ordered that James E. Keith, Jr., have the care, custody, and control of Annie M. Keith, a girl 9 years of age, Bessie May Keith, a girl, 7 years of age, Horace J. Keith, a boy 5 years of age, and Elvin Earle Keith a boy, 2½ years of age, children born of this marriage subject to further orders of this Court.

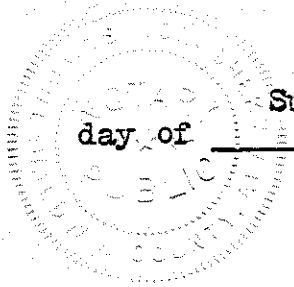

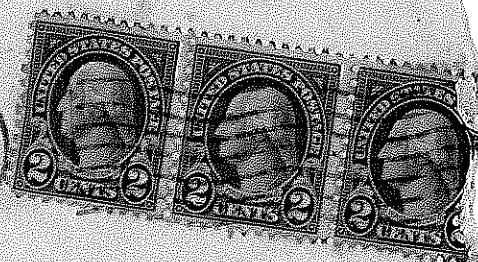
