snaglines and lawful fishtraps, without marking their location by
bouys or floats and identifying such nets and lines by showing the
license number in plain figures upon the bouys or floats, and with-
out at least one such bouy bearing the name and address of the said
J.T. Hall,

contrary to law and against the peace and dignity of the State of Alabama.
