Second.



Third.


That during the year 1921, the said Anna E. Coordes, defendant, voluntarily abandoned your complainant, and that since said time she has remained away voluntarily and continuously.

Howell Hall, witness for the Complainant, testified as follows:

I know J. A. Coordees, and Anna E. Coordees. J. A. Coordees has been a bona fide resident of Baldwin County, Alabama, for more than ten years next preceding the filing of this bill, and is over the age of twenty-one years. The defendant, Anna E. Coordees is a non-resident of the State of Alabama, and I do not know where she lives. On or about June 10, 1916, J. A. Coordees was married to defendant, Anna E. Coordees at Bay Minette, Alabama, and they lived together as man and wife until the year 1921, in Baldwin County, Alabama.

That on or about the year 1921, Anna E. Coordees, the defendant voluntarily abandoned the complainant, J. A. Coordees, and since said 1921 she has remained away voluntarily and continuously. Said voluntarily abandonment was in no way caused by complainant, but he tried many times to get defendant to return to him, but she never would return to him. J. A. Coordees was always good to his wife, and very kind to her and she had no excuse whatever to leave him. This separation occurred in Baldwin County, Alabama.

Ort H. Ertzinger, a witness for the complainant, testified as follows:

My Name is Ort Ertzinger... I know J. A. Coordees and Anna E. Coordees... I have been knowing J. A. Coordes and Anna E. Coordees for more than three years... J. A. Coordees is a bona fide resident of Baldwin County, and has been such resident for more than ten years next preceding the filing of this bill. The defendant, Anna E. Coordees, is a non-resident of the State of Alabama, but I do not know where she lives.

On or about June 10, 1916, J. A. Coordees was married to Anna E. Coordees at Bay Minette, Alabama, and they lived together as man and wife until the year 1921.

During the year 1921, Anna E. Coordees voluntarily abandoned J. A. Coordees ^{and since} ~~at~~ said time she has remained away voluntarily and continuously.
