that

of the State of Alabama.

or operator of a cafe, lunchroom, restaurant, hotel dining room, or other
public place, knowingly permit a person to give away, sell, serve or
drink alcoholic or malt or brewed beverages on the premises of such cafe,
lunchroom, restaurant, hotel dining room, or other public place on Sunday,

contrary to law and against the peace and dignity of the State of Alabama.
