Now comes Amanda Kern, Maggie Snitman, Basheba Nims, Delia Nygarrrd, Barbara Halverson, Roy McCurdy and Marone McCurdy, heirs at law of Reuben McCurdy, deceased, and amends their protest and objections to the confirmation of the report of the commissioners heretofore appointed for the purpose of setting apart exemptions of real and personal property to Sarah McCurdy, to read as follows:

F I R S T.

That the said Sarah McCurdy was never legally married to the said Reuben McCurdy, is not the legal widow of said Reuben McCurdy, and is not entitled to a widow's exemption from the estate of said deceased.

S E C O N D.

In the event that these protestants are mistaken in their belief that there was no legal marriage between Sarah McCurdy and the decedent, and if it be proved to the satisfaction of the Court that Sarah McCurdy is the widow of said decedent, then your Protestants show to the court that the said Sarah McCurdy has already made a selection of personal property from said estate, and has appropriated to her own use property belonging to said estate of the value of \$223.80, consisting of Money, \$150.00 and 123 chickens of the value of 60¢ each or \$73.80, all of which should be considered as a part of the personal property exemption of \$1,000.00 should this Court find Sarah McCurdy entitled to such exemptions.

T H I R D.

The said Commissioners, in addition to appraising personal property of the selection of the claimant to the amount and extent

of \$1,000.00 and setting the same aside as exempt, have gone further and attempted to settle the title to property claimed by both Sarah McCurdy as her own, and by the administrators and heirs of said estate as the property of said estate, and have found and reported that only one-half of the liberty bonds in the hands of the administrators are the property of the estate, but have not found nor reported who is the owner of the other one half of said bonds, but have notwithstanding, allotted and set aside to Sarah McCurdy \$2,000.00 in liberty bonds, which is beyond their power and authority in this, that the exemptions of personal property to the widow, if it be found Sarah McCurdy is the widow, is limited to \$1,000.00 and the commissioners have no power to allot more than \$1,000.00 and have instead, allotted \$2,000.00; that said commissioners have assumed to settle the title and ownership of property claimed by the estate which they have no authority to do and have, by their report allotted and decreed the title to property not exempt or claimed as exempt, all of which is in excess of their lawful authority.

F O U R T H.

That said Sarah McCurdy should not have said exemptions of real and personal property set off to her for in this: That she feloniously caused the death of said Reuben McCurdy by poisoning him.

F I F T H.

That the said Sarah McCurdy should not have said exemptions set apart to her on the ground that she feloniously caused, or procured some one to administer poison to the said Reuben McCurdy, thereby causing his death.

WHEREFORE, your protestants pray that this Court will refuse to confirm the report of said commissioners and will make and enter such order and decree in the premises as may be just and equitable.

TO THE HONORABLE G. W. HUMPHRIES, JUDGE OF SAID COURT:

Come now Amanda Kern, Maggie Snitman, Basheba Nims, Delia Nygaard, Barbara Halverson, Ray McCurdy and Marone McCurdy, heirs at law of Reuben McCurdy, deceased, and protest and object to the confirmation of the report of the commissioners, heretofore appointed for the purpose of setting apart exemptions of real and personal property to Sarah McCurdy, as the widow of said Reuben McCurdy, and as grounds for such protest and objection, respectfully show to the Court:

FIRST.

That the said Sarah McCurdy was never legally married to the said Reuben McCurdy, is not the legal widow of said Reuben McCurdy, and is not entitled to a widow's exemption from the estate of said deceased.

SECOND.


