FREDERICK DOUGLAS FIELDS, WHOSE NAME IS TO THE GRAND JURY OTHERWISE UNKNOWN, WHO WAS THE DRIVER OF A VEHICLE, TO-WIT: AN AUTOMOBILE, UPON A PUBLIC HIGHWAY IN BALDWIN COUNTY, ALABAMA, WHICH SAID AUTOMOBILE WAS INVOLVED IN AN ACCIDENT RESULTING IN INJURY, OR DEATH, TO A PERSON, TO-WIT: JESSIE LUCIOUS, OR DAMAGE TO A VEHICLE, UPON A PUBLIC HIGHWAY IN BALDWIN COUNTY, ALABAMA, DID NOT GIVE HIS NAME AND ADDRESS AND THE REGISTRATION LICENSE NUMBER OF HIS VEHICLE, AND DID NOT RENDER TO THE SAID JESSIE LUCIOUS, THE PERSON INJURED IN SUCH ACCIDENT, REASONABLE ASSISTANCE, INCLUDING THE CARRYING OF SUCH PERSON INJURED TO A PHYSICIAN OR SURGEON FOR MEDICAL OR SURGICAL TREATMENT, IT BEING APPARENT THAT SUCH TREATMENT WAS NECESSARY OR WAS REQUESTED BY SUCH INJURED PERSON, OR DID NOT IMMEDIATELY STOP SUCH VEHICLE AT THE SCENE OF SAID ACCIDENT,
