Lowery and Julian Steeley, and respectfully represent that they are confined in the Baldwin County, Alabama, jail, under a commitment issued by Justice of the Peace Hon T. C. Hand, charged with ten offenses of burglary, second degree; and said offense occured and we have been committed for more than fifteen days; and that we desire to plead guilty to said offenses in the said Circuit Court before indictment under the provisions of Section 260, Title 15, Code of Alabama, 1940, as amended.

And we pray the Court to instruct and request and notify the Circuit Solicitor of the 28th Judicial Circuit, Baldwin County, Alabama, to file a sworn verified charge in the manner and form as provided by law. And that Your Honor forthwith set same down for hearing and trial, not less than three days from the date of the Solicitor filing said charge; and that on said date of hearing Your Honor hear and determine your petitioners' plea of guilty, and fix your petitioners' punishment and forthwith sentence your petitioners to the penitentiary of the State of Alabama. And we pray for general relief.
