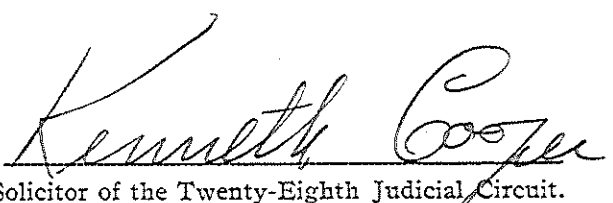
a convict, did escape or attempt to escape from the penitentiary,
