doth depose and say as follows:

My name is Etta Mae Pedigo and I am over the age of twenty-one years and am a resident of Baldwin County, Alabama. Peter M. Pedigo is also a resident of Baldwin County, Alabama, and over the age of twenty-one years. On November 26th, 1928 Peter M. Pedigo and I were married and are now husband and wife. On the first day of October 1929, the Defendant struck me and abused me and I was in constant fear of bodily harm from Peter M. Pedigo. On or about October 1, 1929 the Defendant left and abandoned me and at that time I was pregnant with a child which was born three months after the abandonment. The Defendant has failed and refused to support me and said child and I was forced to live with my father and mother who ever since supported me. I did not give the Defendant any cause whatever for his treatment of me. There is one child, a girl, Gloria Mae Pedigo, nine months of age, the result of my marriage. I am capable of caring for said child and the Defendant is an unfit person to have the care and custody of the child.

Annie Brice a witness for the Complainant being duly sworn, deposes and says as follows:

My name is Annie Brice and I live in Baldwin County, Alabama, and I know Peter M. Pedigo and Etta Mae Pedigo. I lived at the Modern Hotel in Foley, Alabama, which was run by Etta Mae Pedigo and during the month of October, 1929, Peter M. Pedigo struck Etta Mae Pedigo, cursed and abused her, without any fault on her part. Peter M. Pedigo left his wife and refused to return to her. During the entire three months I was at the Modern Hotel I knew of no occasion on which Peter M. Pedigo furnished and support for his wife. Mrs. Pedigo seemed to be afraid that he would harm her.

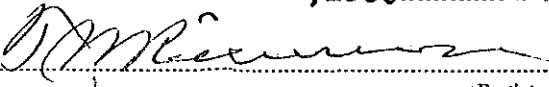

To the Honorable F. W. Hare, Judge of the Circuit Court,

Now comes Etta Mae Pedigo and humbly complaining against
Peter M. Pedigo respectfully shows unto your Honor as follows:

First.

That your complainant and defendant herein are both residents
of Baldwin County, Alabama, and are each over the age of twenty one years.

Second.

That on November 6, 1928, your complainant and said defendant
intermarried in due form of law, and have been ever since, and now are,
husband and wife. That on the 1st. day of October, 1929, said defendant
struck complainant and abused her and she was, and is, constantly in
fear and dread of bodily harm from defendant. That said defendant left
and abandoned complainant while she was pregnant with a child, which was
born three months after said abandonment. That he has failed and refused
to support her or said child ever since and she was forced to take up her
abode with her father and mother, who have since supported her. That com-
plainant gave said defendant no cause for such conduct as she was always
a dutiful wife.

Third.

Complainant further shows that as a result of said marriage
there was born one child, a girl now nine months of age, named Gloria
Mae Pedigo.

Fourth.

The premises considered your complainant prays that said
defendant be made a party to this bill; that the care, custody and con-
trol of said child, Gloria Mae Pedigo be awarded to your complainant;
that upon the hearing your Honor will order, adjudge and decree that
the bond of matrimony existing between complainant and defendant be
forever dissolved, and for such other and further relief as may in

Equity be due your complainant.

It is further ordered, adjudged and decreed that said Etta Mae Pedigo, shall not again marry except to said Peter M. Pedigo, until sixty days after this date, and that if an appeal is taken within sixty days s. he shall not marry again except to said Peter M. Pedigo,

It is further ordered that Etta Mae Pedigo, have the care, custody, and control of Gloria Mae Pedigo, a girl child born of this marriage, pending further orders of this Court, This 25 th day of November, 1930
