This cause comes ^{ON} regularly to be heard on this the 29th day of August, 1930, a day heretofore regularly set, and the Defendant, George Harville, being present in court in person and by and through Hon. Frank Horne, as his Attorney, and the State of Alabama being represented by Norborne Stone, the Court proceeds to a hearing and trial hereon and hereof.

The Defendant being arraigned, pleads "Not Guilty", whereupon the court proceeds to the hearing of the evidence offered for both the State and Defendant and upon consideration thereof by the court it is

ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED by the Court that the Defendant, George Harville, is and hereby is adjudged to be guilty of causing Thelma Harville and Virginia Harville, children under sixteen years of age and of whom the Defendant is a parent, to become and remain dependent and neglected and that he be and hereby is sentenced to pay a fine of Fifty Dollars (\$50.00), it is further;


ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the Defendant be and he hereby is placed on probation for a term of twelve months from the date hereof conditioned upon his paying into this Court the sum of Fifteen Dollars (\$15.00) each month for the maintenance and care of said children, and that he be and hereby is required to enter into ^{IN THE SUM OF \$250.00} bond with Surety as required by law, conditioned upon the Defendant complying with the Orders of this Court, and that upon the Defendant entering into said bond the payment of the fine stands suspended and it is further,

ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that this Court retain full control and jurisdiction of this cause.

Now comes the Defendant through his attorney and prays for an appeal to the next ensuing term of the Circuit Court of Baldwin County, demanding a trial by Jury. Motion for Appeal is granted and it is ordered that the Defendant enter into an Appeal Bond with sufficient Sureties in the sum of Two Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$250.00) conditioned that he will appear at said Circuit Court until discharged by due process of law.


