My name is Pauline Shea. I am a resident of Baldwin, County, Alabama, over twenty-one years of age, and have been such a resident for more than three years next preceding the filing of the Bill of Complaint in this cause. John J. Shea, Jr., the respondent, is over twenty-one years of age and a resident of Baldwin County, Alabama, but has for the past two months been temporarily away from Baldwin County, Alabama, and in Memphis, Tennessee. John J. Shea, Jr., and I were married at Titusville, Florida, on or about January 4, 1928. We lived together until on or about April 1st, 1931. We were living at Bay Minette, Baldwin County, Alabama, at the time of our separation. At the time we were married the respondent drank very little, if at all, but soon after our marriage he took to the use of strong drinks, which habit grew on him from time to time until he became an habitual drunkard. His conduct, on account of his drinking habit, grew worse from time to time until he reached the stage that he lost or ignored all his sense of responsibility as to his personal obligations and also to his obligations due the complainant. In fact he had reached the

stage, when I could no longer live with him, that he absolutely lost all sense of responsibility toward me and failed to supply me with clothing and the necessities of life. He subsequent to our marriage became addicted to habitual drunkenness.

Pauline Shea

Mrs. J. F. Dolive a witness for the Complainant being duly sworn, deposes and says:

My name is Mrs. J. F. Dolive. I am a resident of Bay Minette, Baldwin County, Alabama; I am the Mother of Pauline Sheave the Complaimant in the above styled cause; My daughter, Pauline, and the respondent John J. Shea Jr were married at Titusville, Florida in January, 1928; They lived together as husband and wife until about April 1st, 1931; The respondent soon after, he and my daughter were married came to Bay Minette to live, and soon after his marriage he beacme addicted to the use of liquor, which habit grew on him from time to time until he lost all responsibility of his obligations and his duties toward his wife; When he was using drikks it was impossible to manage him and his conduct was such that no one could hardly stay around him; on one particular occasion he went an a rampage at my house and shot holes through the door and also through the water container, in fact when under one of his spekis he was dangerous. I know of my own personal knowledge that my daughter could not live with him. He on several occasions went away and left her without any means of support, and she was dependent on her family and friends. Conditions were such, due to his use of strong drinks, that Pauline could not live with him, and had to leave him.

This cause coming on to be heard, was submitted upon the Bill of Complaint on behalf of the complainant, Answer and Agreement of the Defendant and testimony as noted by the Register, and upon consideration thereof the Court is of the opinion that the Complainant is entitled to the relief prayed for in said Bill.

It is therefore ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED by the Court that the bonds of matrimony heretofore existing between the Complainant and Respondent be and the same are hereby dissolved and the Complainant is forever divorced from the Respondent on the ground of habitual drunkenness.

It is further ORDERED that the said Pauline Shea be and she is hereby permitted to again contract marriage upon the payment of the costs of court in this cause.

It is further ORDERED that the said Pauline Shea pay the costs herein taxed, for which execution may issue.

It is further ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED that the said Pauline Shea shall not again marry except to the said John J. Shea, Jr., until sixty days after this date, and that if an appeal is taken within sixty days, she shall not marry again, except to John J. Shea, Jr., during the pendency of the appeal.

Comes your defendant, John J. Shea, Jr., and for answer to the complaint filed against him in this cause, respectfully shows, to-wit:

I.

He admits that both complainant and defendant have been residents of Baldwin County, Alabama for more than three whole years next preceding the filing of the Bill; he admits that he is temporarily away from Baldwin County, Alabama, and leaving in Memphis, Tennessee.

II.

Your defendant admits that he and complainant were intermarried on January 4, 1928, at Titusville, Florida, and that he and complainant lived together as husband and wife for until on or about April 1, 1931.

III.

Your defendant denies that after his marriage he became addicted to habitual drunkenness. He denies that his conduct from time to time grew worse until it reached such a stage that he ignored all responsibilities as to his personal obligations and to obligations due the complainant. Defendant calls for strict proof on these allegations in the original petition filed against him in this cause, but notice of the time of taking the proof is waived.

All allegations of the complainant's bill filed in this cause not hereinabove specifically admitted or denied, are now denied, and denied as fully and completely as if taken up separately and denied in detail.

WHEREFORE, your defendant respectfully prays to be hence dismissed with his costs.
