Davis that in said County and within twelve months before the commencement of this prosecution he did use and electrical device or other device or instrument capable of taking, catching, stunning or killing game or non-game fish which is not expressly allowed by law or regulation of the Department of Conservation of the State of Alabama,

contrary to law and against the peace and dignity of the State of Alabama.
