The State of Alabama, by its Solicitor, complains of JAMES TUCKER

that

in said county and within twelve months before the commencement of this prosecution he did TAKE, CATCH, STUN OR KILL, OR ATTEMPTED TO TAKE, CATCH, STUN OR KILL GAME OR NON-GAME FISH BY MEANS OTHER THAN THOSE WHICH ARE EXPRESSLY ALLOWED BY LAW OR REGULATION OF THE DEPARTMENT OF CONSERVATION OF THE STATE OF ALABAMA, IN THE PUBLIC WATERS OF THE STATE OF ALABAMA, contrary to law and against the peace and dignity of the State of Alabama.

COUNT NO. 2

The State of Alabama, by its Solicitor, complains of James Tucker that in said County and within twelve months before the commencement of this prosecution he did use an electrical device or other device or instrument capable of taking, catching, stunning or killing game or non-game fish which is not expressly allowed by law or regulation of the Department of Conservation of the State of Alabama,

contrary to law and against the peace and dignity of the State of Alabama.
