made to the City of ~~MOBILE~~ Fairhope do hereby bind ourselves, and our heirs and assigns, jointly and severally, firmly by these presents.
Sealed with our seals, and dated the 24 day of January in the year of our Lord, one thousand
nine hundred and 59.

The condition of this Obligation is such that whereas the said Baldwin has on the




