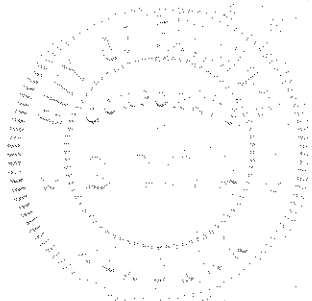

and G. M. Pierce and C. V. Brooks as Sureties, are held and firmly bound unto the
City of ~~MOBILE~~ Fairhope in the sum of (\$ 300.00) Dollars, for which payment well and truly to be
made to the City of ~~MOBILE~~ Fairhope do hereby bind ourselves, and our heirs and assigns, jointly and severally, firmly by these presents.

Sealed with our seals, and dated the 24 day of January in the year of our Lord, one thousand
nine hundred and 59

The condition of this Obligation is such that whereas the said Herbert J. Williams has on the
date of these presents claimed an appeal to the Circuit Court of ~~MOBILE~~ Baldwin County, next to be held in and for the County of ~~MOBILE~~ Baldwin, in the
State aforesaid, at the Present Session, thereof from a judgment rendered against him on the 2 day of Jan
1959, for the Offense of Obtaining money under false

pretense
by the Recorder of the City of ~~MOBILE~~ Fairhope, State of Alabama.

NOW, if the said Herbert J. Williams shall appear at the present Session of said Circuit Court,

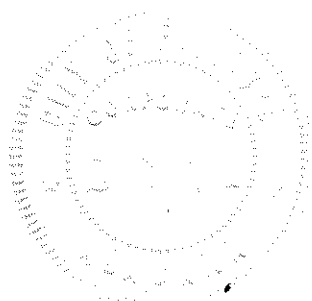
