This cause coming on to be heard in vacation was submitted upon the bill of complaint, answer and testimony as noted by the Register and upon consideration thereof the Court is of the opinion that the Complainant is entitled to the relief prayed for in his said bill.

It is therefore ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED that the bonds of matrimony heretofore existing between the Complainant and Respondent be and the same hereby are dissolved and the said Wray W. Allen is forever divorced from the said Mildred E. Allen on account of desertion as alleged in the bill of complaint.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the parties hereto be and they are hereby permitted to again contract marriage upon the payment of the costs in this cause.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the said Wray W. Allen pay the costs herein taxed for which execution may issue and if such execution be returned "no property found" then execution for such costs may issue against the said Wray W. Allen.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that neither party marry again except to the other until sixty days after this date, and that if an appeal be taken within sixty days neither shall marry except to the other during the pendency of said appeal.

The said witnesses appeared before me the day and year hereinafter stated and having been sworn testified in answer to the interrogatories propounded to them as follows:


W R A Y W . A L L E N .

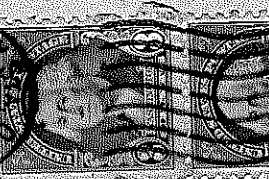
