ATTEMPTED RAPE

My name is:

Glenavis Harrison

This is a free and voluntary statement on my part.

One day at the house my father sent my brother out of the house, he got a switch and made me "Do it with him." He asked me if he could do it to me and I told him no. He started wrestling with me and throwed me down on the bed. pulled my pants down and went ahead with what he started do. When he got off of me, he went outside.

After this day my father tried the same thing again. but he only got as far as pulling up my dress.

June 20, 1959

He took me 3 miles out on a dirt road. He started wrestling with me. He pulled my dress up, he said if I didn't do what he wanted me to do he would pour gas on me. When we went home I sat on the couch and started combing my hair. He came over there and started wrestlin with me. I got up and went over and sat on the bed with my Aunt. He set down on the side of the bed and slapped me. After he slapped me, he got up and went back to Robertsedale and went to work.

That was the last time he tried anything.
