I got out of jail this A.M. about 8:00. Went to Jack's house. He had an argument with his father. We came back to Mobile and tried to get Jack's brother to give us enough money to get thru the tunnel. We came to Foley on the way to Pensacola. We stopped at Carte's Shed. We stayed there about 5 minutes. We walked down to that store to wait for a ride. Then we came back to Carte's Shed and got a piece of metal we saw there. We came back to the store. We looked around to see if anyone was looking, we both pried the door open. We took cigarettes first, then took the pennies out of the cash register. When we left we saw a man drive up in a pink and grey Pontiac. We walked toward Pensacola. We decided to go back home. We were standing on the side of the road when we were picked up.
