State aforesaid, at the Present Session, thereof from a judgment rendered against him on the 4 day of June
1960, for the Offense of Driving while Intoxicated

by the Recorder of the City of Mobile State of Alabama

NOW, if the said Robert Travis shall appear at the present Session of said Circuit Court,
and from Session to Session thereafter until discharged by due process of law, then this obligation to be void, otherwise to remain in
full force and virtue.

And we each do hereby waive all right of exemptions allowed us under the Constitution and Laws of the State of Alabama as to
the collection of this bond if forfeited.
