COUNT 1

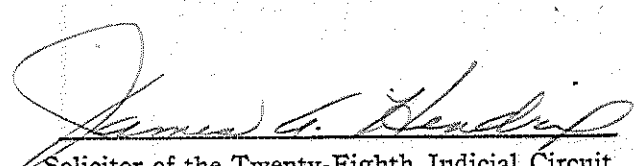
The Grand Jury of said County charge that before finding this indictment

COUNT 2

The Grand Jury of said County charge that before finding this indictment Alton Mosley, whose name is to the Grand Jury otherwise unknown, did, within the State of Alabama, transport ten (10) gallons of moonshine whiskey, the transportation of which is prohibited by law in the State of Alabama,

against the peace and dignity of the State of Alabama.
