My name is Sam Dale, I am 23 years old, and I live in

left me very soon afterwards, without any fault on my part. On
the first day of November last Dorinda started going with Horace
Jackson and went to live with him at his house and stayed with
him at nights and slept with him as his wife. She has continued
living with Jackson nearly all winter and until a short time ago.
Since she started to live with Horace Jackson last Fall I have never
lived with her as my wife and never had anything whatever to do
with her. The Defendant, Dorinda Young Dale, is over the age
of 18 years.

My name is Joe Garner. I am 27 years old and I live near Fairhope in Baldwin county, Alabama. I have known Sam Dale and Dorinda Young Dale about six years; they both live in Baldwin county, Ala. He is past twenty one years of age and she is over eighteen years old. Sam and Dorinda were married some time in the Spring of the year 1930. Some time last Fall, about the first part of November, 1930, Dorinda Young Dale, the Defendant, went over to Horace Jackson's house and stayed with him. She stayed there at night and lived with him for several months and has continued to live with him at his place until recently. Horace Jackson is a young man about 26 years old and Dorinda has been living with him as his wife during all of this past winter.






