While operating a vehicle upon a public highway in said County and State, passed a School Bus which was loading and unloading children.

() Failing To Stop at Stop Sign

While operating a vehicle upon a public highway in said County and State, and upon reaching an intersection which was equipped with a stop-sign, failed to obey said stop-sign by not coming to a complete stop.
