was on the 5 day of June, 1931, convicted in the Mayor's Court of Bay Minette, Alabama, of the offense of Disorderly Conduct + Resisting Lawful Arrest

and by Judgment of Sam Le Grante as Mayor of the said Town of Bay Minette, Alabama, sentenced to thirty days in County Jail or \$50.00 + cost \$685 - \$568.50

And whereas, the said James Bishop

has this day prayed an appeal from said judgment to the Circuit Court of Baldwin County, Alabama.

Now, if the said James Bishop

shall appear at the next term of the said Circuit Court and from term to term thereafter until discharged, and abide by and perform whatever sentence may be adjudged in said court against him, then the above obligation to be void; otherwise to remain in full force and effect.
