Comes your Complainant, Joseph Spacek, and exhibits this, his Bill of Complaint, against the Respondent, Mary Spacel and for grounds therefor shows:

FIRST:

That your Complainant and the Respondent are over the age of twenty-one years and are of sound mind; that your Complains a bona fide resident of Silverhill in Baldwin County, Alabama having been such a resident for more than three years next immediately preceding the filing of this Bill; that the Respondent is a non-resident of the State of Alabama, residing at 28062 Sevent Street, Los Angeles, California, when last heard of by your Complainant.

The premises considered, Complainant prays that Respon be made a party defendant to this cause by the usual processes of law; that upon a final hearing your Honor will render, adjudge and decree that the Bonds of Matrimony heretofore existing betwee your Complainant and the Respondent be forever discharged and that your Complainant be again permitted to contract marriage (page one)

This cause, coming on to be heard at this Term, was submitted upon the Bill of Complaint, Decree Pro Confesso by Registered mail, and the Testimony as noted by the Register; and upon consideration thereof, the Court is of opinion that the Complainant is entitled to the relief prayed for in said bill.

IT IS: THEREFORE, ordered, adjudged and decreed by the Court, that the bonds of matrimony heretofore existing between the Complainant and Defendant be, and the same are hereby dissoled, and the Complainant is forever divorced from the Defendant.

It is further ordered, that the said Joseph Spacek be, and he is hereby permitted to again contract marriage, upon the payment of the costs of Court in this cause.

It is further ordered, that the said Joseph Spacek pay the costs herein taxes, for which execution may issue, and if successcution is returned "no property found," then execution for success may issue against the said Mary Mary .

It is further ordered, adjudged and decreed that said Joseph Spacek shall not again marry except to said Mary Spacek until sixty days after this date, and that if an appeal is taken within sixty days he shall not marry again except to said Mary Spacek during the pendency of said appeal.
