It is further ordered that LEON LAMBERT be, and IS hereby permitted to again contract marriage upon the payment of the cost of this suit.

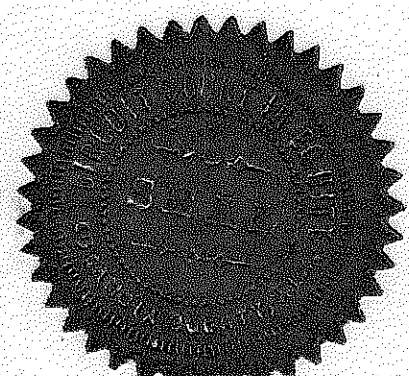
It is further ordered that LEON LAMBERT the COMPLAINANT pay the cost herein to be taxed, for which execution may issue.
