Conway, Frank Conway and Edward Conway, minors, denying the allegations of the Bill of Complaint, notice and acceptance of guardian ad litem, decree pro confesso on personal service against Minnie Lee Johansen, Henry Conway, Jessie Conway, J. V. Conway, Herman Conway, Pearl Conway Summerall, Mary Conway Fox by Registered mail, return receipt demanded, decrees pro confesso on publications.

The pleading and evidence in this cause shows that John T. Stanton, the Complainant aforesaid, acquired the following described property in 1921, to-wit:

TRACT NO. 1. Starting at the Northwest Corner of Section Twenty-two, Township Five South of Range Four East, thence running South forty Chains to a stake for a beginning corner, thence East Twenty Chains to a stake; thence South Ten chains, thence West Twenty Chains, thence North Ten Chains to the place of beginning.

It is further ordered, adjudged and decreed that a copy of the foregoing opinion and this decree shall be filed in the Probate Judge's office by the Register of this Court and recorded therein and is to be indexed in the direct index in said said office in the name of J. V. Conway, et al., and in the indirect index in the name of John T. Stanton.

It is further ordered, adjudged and decreed that the Complainant pay the cost of these proceedings.
