PRAYER FOR RELIEF:


That upon the final hearing of this cause, your Honor will grant unto your Orator an absolute divorce.

Testimony of Coma Long:

My name is Coma Long and I am over twenty - one years of age and have lived in Baldwin County, Alabama, more than three years next before filing this bill and reside at Rabon, Baldwin County, Alabama. I was over twenty-one years when this suit for divorce was filed.

Callie Long is my wife and she is over twenty-one years of age and reside at Rabon, Baldwin County, Alabama.

We are married during the year 1922, and lived together as man and wife until the month of September, 1930, at which time Callie Long voluntarily abandoned me and without cause on my part. She has not lived with me since. She left me while we were living at Rabon in said County. Callie Long lives both at Rabon Alabama and at Perdido Station Alabama.

Testimony of Earnest Rabon:

My name is Earnest Rabon. I have known Coma Long and Callie Long his wife for the past five years and know that Callie Long voluntarily abandoned Coma Long during the month of September, 1930 and that she has not lived with him since. Both Callie Long and Coma Long are over twenty-one years of age and reside at Rabon, Alabama, but Callie Long also lives at Perdido Station a part of the time. They have lived in Baldwin County, Alabama for a period of more than the last three years just before this suit was filed for divorce.
