

The condition of the above obligation is such that whereas, the Baldwin County Bank, a Corporation, did on the 6th day of December, 1933, sue out of the Circuit Court of Baldwin County, Alabama, a writ in detinue directed to any sheriff of the State of Alabama, commanding him to take into his possession the following described property, to-wit: One cream colored horse about 9 years old; one black colored horse about 8 years old; five head of stock cattle being grown cows; one two horse wagon and set of harness.

Which said writ was placed in the hands of W. R.
