(1) Plaintiff claims of the defendant the sum of One Hundred Ninety-five and 30/100 (\$195.30) Dollars, due from him by account on, to-wit, the 16th day of October, 1931, which sum of money, with the interest thereon, is due and still unpaid.

(2) Plaintiff claims of the defendant the sum of One Hundred Ninety-five and 30/100 (\$195.30) Dollars, due from him by account stated between the plaintiff and defendant on, to-wit, the 16th day of October, 1931, which sum of money, with the interest thereon, is due and still unpaid.

(3) Plaintiff claims of the defendant the sum of One Hundred Ninety-five and 30/100 (\$195.30) Dollars, due from him for merchandise, goods and chattels sold the defendant on, to-wit, the 16th day of October, 1931, which sum of money, with the interest thereon, is due and still unpaid.

An itemized statement of the account, verified by the affidavit of a competent witness, is filed with the original summons and complaint in this cause.

(4) Plaintiff claims of the defendant ONE Hundred Ninety-five and 30/100 (\$195.30) Dollars, damages for the breach of an agreement entered into by him on the 1st day of July, 1929, a true and correct copy of which agreement is hereto attached and made a part hereof, the same as if set out in full; plaintiff avers that under and by the terms of said agreement it furnished to the defendant merchandise of the value of One Hundred Ninety-five and 30/100 (\$195.30) Dollars, that it

has not received payment for said merchandise and that the sum of One Hundred Ninety-five and 30/100 (\$195.30) Dollars, with interest thereon, is due and still unpaid, hence this suit.

Plaintiff avers that as against the payment of any amount due on said agreement, defendant, in and by the terms of said agreement, waived all rights of exemption as to personal property under the Constitution and Laws of the State of Alabama.

Plaintiff claims a further and additional sum of Eighty and No/100 (\$80.00) Dollars, as a reasonable attorney's fee for collecting the amount due on said agreement, which defendant agreed to pay by the terms of said agreement.

for the payment of which well and truly to be made, we bind ourselves, our heirs, our executors and administrators.

The condition of the above obligation is such that the said A. A. Trione

have entered into a contract with the said

Loveman, Joseph & Loeb for the handling and sale of the School Text Books for Daphne

County of Baldwin, under acts of the Legislature of Alabama, said acts and said contracts with the said Loveman, Joseph & Loeb being incorporated and made part of this bond; the

said A. A. Trione, being responsible for said books.

It is hereby expressly agreed that the neglect or forbearance on the part of the said Loveman, Joseph & Loeb in enforcing payment of such sum as may become due, or the forbearance on its part to enforce the performance of such covenants and conditions as is set forth in said contract or the extension by it for the payment or performance thereof, shall not in any way release the said sureties, or either of them, and the said sureties expressly waive their right to notice of any breach or violation of any of the terms of this contract.

Now, therefore, if the said A. A. Trione shall well and truly perform the conditions of said contract, then this obligation is to be void, otherwise to remain in full force and effect.

This Contract, made and entered into this the 1st day of July, 19 29,
by and between LOVEMAN, JOSEPH & LOEB, a corporation, at Birmingham, Alabama, party of the first part, (hereinafter
called the first party), and A. A. Trione

of Daphne, County of Baldwin, State of Alabama,
(hereinafter called the second party), WITNESSETH, that

WHEREAS, under the provisions of an Act of the Legislature of the State of Alabama, certain publishing companies have entered into Contracts with said State, to furnish, for exclusive use in its public and high schools, certain text-books, set forth in said contracts, at the contract prices as fixed by said contracts, and at no higher prices; and

WHEREAS, said contracts provide that said publishing companies shall establish and maintain a central depository and agencies for the supply and distribution of said books, provided for in said Act and said contracts; and said contracts contain other stipulations and provisions, all of which are hereby referred to, incorporated in, and made part hereof; and

WHEREAS, the first party has been appointed as the depository of the said several publishing companies at the City of Birmingham, Alabama, for the distribution of said books, under said Act and said contracts, in all of the counties of said State, with which publishing companies the first party has entered into contracts, all of which are hereby referred to, incorporated in, and made a part hereof; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary for the first party to establish sub-depositories in all of the counties of the State of Alabama for the distribution of said books:

NOW THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) to the first party in hand paid by the second party, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, and in further consideration of the covenants hereinafter set forth in this instrument, the said first party hereby covenants and agrees as follows:

1. That the second party shall have an agency at Daphne, Alabama
County of Baldwin, State of Alabama, for the sale of the said text-books, to residents of that place, and to all patrons of the public schools who trade there.

2. That the first party will consign to the second party a supply of each of the said books, to enable him to carry out the contract, with reference to introduction and exchanges in the schools of his locality. Shipments weighing 100 pounds or more transportation charges prepaid, and charges on shipments weighing less than 100 pounds shall be paid by second party. The first party will allow the second party for and as his sole compensation for his services hereunder, at settlement, to deduct a commission of Ten (10%) per cent. from the cash collected as remitted by him.

AND THE SECOND PARTY, for and in consideration of the sum of One (\$1.00) Dollar, in hand paid by the first party, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, and in further consideration of being given an agency for handling the said text-books at said place, in said county, hereby covenants and agrees as follows:

1. To order from the first party and keep constantly on hand, a stock of the said books sufficient to supply all demands; and not materially more than sufficient for demands, and promptly account and pay to party of first part not later than the 6th day of each month, for all books sold during the preceding month, and hold the money derived from the sale of said books separate and intact as the property of party of first part, and to sell the books at retail to the pupils and patrons of the public schools, at the retail contract price printed on each book; and to make exchanges of books, in accordance with said contracts of the publishers with the State of Alabama.

2. The second party agrees that he will on or before the 6th of each month following, during the term of this contract, make statements and settlements of accounts and a statement of books on hand, paying at once the amount shown to be due on such settlement, and to permit the first party from time to time, in person or by agent, as often as the first party shall see fit, to examine the books and papers of the second party in which are kept the accounts and transactions under this contract and all receipts, sales and deliveries, and books on hand. Second party shall inventory such books on the last day of each month and furnish first party a copy thereof with his monthly report.

3. The second party agrees that he will not sell, supply or furnish any of the books herein named to any person, firm or company outside the State of Alabama, under any circumstances; and that he will not sell said books to any person, firm or company within the State of Alabama, except at the retail contract prices on said books.

4. The second party agrees that he will not keep in stock, or sell, or offer for sale, any edition whatever of the adopted books, except the Alabama State Contract Edition, to be supplied to him by the first party exclusively; and that he will not keep in stock, sell, or offer for sale, second-hand copies of any of the above named books.

5. The second party agrees to take good care of all books on hand so that they shall not become worn or unmerchantable, and shall be responsible for all damages to them, or loss thereof, from any cause whatever.

6. It is mutually agreed that this contract shall continue for the term of six (6) years, provided the second party shall continue and remain in business for that length of time; but the first party shall have the right to terminate said agency upon the failure of the second party to comply with any term or condition of this contract. Said first party shall also have the right to terminate this contract in the event that the contract between the State and any of said publishers shall be terminated for any cause, or in the event that the party of the first part shall cease to be said State Depository and either party shall have the right to terminate same upon thirty (30) days' notice in writing, with or without cause.

7. The second party agrees that if he shall fail or refuse to keep in stock a sufficient supply of books and sell them at the contract prices, and if on account of such failure or refusal the party of the first part should be required to pay any of the penalties provided for in said contracts between the party of the first part and said publishers, or between said publishers and the State of Alabama, or if the party of the first part should thereby sustain any other loss or damage, then the second party agrees to pay the amount of such penalties or other loss or damage sustained by the party of the first part and to hold harmless the first party against any loss, liability or damage whatever by reason of such defaults of the party of the second part.

8. IT IS FURTHER AGREED by the parties hereto, that the amount of stock which may be returned by the party of the second part at the expiration of this contract, and for which party of the first part shall give the second party credit, shall not exceed twenty (20%) per cent. of the amount of sales of such book reported to party of the first part during the preceding twelve (12) months, and any excess of 20% shall be paid for by second party the same as if same had been sold.

9. Final settlement shall be made and all books returned to first party F. O. B. Birmingham, Alabama, case and cartage paid, and all moneys due shall be paid immediately upon termination of contract.

10. The second party agrees, within ten days from the date hereof, to furnish first party a bond, with a surety company approved by first party as surety, in the sum of \$ 1,000, conditioned for the faithful performance of each and all of the obligations of the second party, under this contract. Suit for enforcement of any obligation or liability under this contract may be brought against principal and sureties on said bond in the Circuit Court of Jefferson County, Alabama, at Birmingham.

11. The right of exemption is hereby waived as provided in Constitution and Laws of the State of Alabama, or any other State in the United States, and it is further agreed that the undersigned second party shall pay all costs of collection for the enforcement of any of the terms or provisions of this contract, including a reasonable attorney's fee.

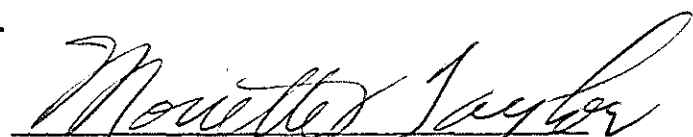

It is hereby expressly agreed that the neglect or forbearance on the part of the said Loveman, Joseph & Loeb in enforcing payment of such sum as may become due, or the forbearance on its part to enforce the performance of such covenants and conditions as is set forth in said contract or the extension by it for the payment or performance thereof, shall not in any way release the said sureties, or either of them, and the said sureties expressly waive their right to notice of any breach or violation of any of the terms of this contract.

Now, therefore, if the said A. A. Trione shall well and truly perform the conditions of said contract, then this obligation is to be void, otherwise to remain in full force and effect.

This Contract, made and entered into this the 1st day of July, 1929, by and between LOVEMAN, JOSEPH & LOEB, a corporation, at Birmingham, Alabama, party of the first part, (hereinafter called the first party), and A. A. Trione

of Daphne, County of Baldwin, State of Alabama, (hereinafter called the second party), WITNESSETH, that

WHEREAS, under the provisions of an Act of the Legislature of the State of Alabama, certain publishing companies have entered into Contracts with said State, to furnish, for exclusive use in its public and high schools, certain text-books, set forth in said contracts, at the contract prices as fixed by said contracts, and at no higher prices; and

WHEREAS, said contracts provide that said publishing companies shall establish and maintain a central depository and agencies for the supply and distribution of said books, provided for in said Act and said contracts; and said contracts contain other stipulations and provisions, all of which are hereby referred to, incorporated in, and made part hereof; and

WHEREAS, the first party has been appointed as the depository of the said several publishing companies at the City of Birmingham, Alabama, for the distribution of said books, under said Act and said contracts, in all of the counties of said State, with which publishing companies the first party has entered into contracts, all of which are hereby referred to, incorporated in, and made a part hereof; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary for the first party to establish sub-depositories in all of the counties of the State of Alabama for the distribution of said books:

NOW THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) to the first party in hand paid by the second party, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, and in further consideration of the covenants hereinafter set forth in this instrument, the said first party hereby covenants and agrees as follows:

1. That the second party shall have an agency at Daphne, Alabama County of Baldwin, State of Alabama, for the sale of the said text-books, to residents of that place, and to all patrons of the public schools who trade there.

2. That the first party will consign to the second party a supply of each of the said books, to enable him to carry out the contract, with reference to introduction and exchanges in the schools of his locality. Shipments weighing 100 pounds or more transportation charges prepaid, and charges on shipments weighing less than 100 pounds shall be paid by second party. The first party will allow the second party for and as his sole compensation for his services hereunder, at settlement, to deduct a commission of Ten (10%) per cent. from the cash collected as remitted by him.

AND THE SECOND PARTY, for and in consideration of the sum of One (\$1.00) Dollar, in hand paid by the first party, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, and in further consideration of being given an agency for handling the said text-books at said place, in said county, hereby covenants and agrees as follows:

1. To order from the first party and keep constantly on hand, a stock of the said books sufficient to supply all demands; and not materially more than sufficient for demands, and promptly account and pay to party of first part not later than the 6th day of each month, for all books sold during the preceding month, and hold the money derived from the sale of said books separate and intact as the property of party of first part, and to sell the books at retail to the pupils and patrons of the public schools, at the retail contract price printed on each book; and to make exchanges of books, in accordance with said contracts of the publishers with the State of Alabama.

2. The second party agrees that he will on or before the 6th of each month following, during the term of this contract, make statements and settlements of accounts and a statement of books on hand, paying at once the amount shown to be due on such settlement, and to permit the first party from time to time, in person or by agent, as often as the first party shall see fit, to examine the books and papers of the second party in which are kept the accounts and transactions under this contract and all receipts, sales and deliveries, and books on hand. Second party shall inventory such books on the last day of each month and furnish first party a copy thereof with his monthly report.

3. The second party agrees that he will not sell, supply or furnish any of the books herein named to any person, firm or company outside the State of Alabama, under any circumstances; and that he will not sell said books to any person, firm or company within the State of Alabama, except at the retail contract prices on said books.

4. The second party agrees that he will not keep in stock, or sell, or offer for sale, any edition whatever of the adopted books, except the Alabama State Contract Edition, to be supplied to him by the first party exclusively; and that he will not keep in stock, sell, or offer for sale, second-hand copies of any of the above named books.

5. The second party agrees to take good care of all books on hand so that they shall not become worn or unmerchantable, and shall be responsible for all damages to them, or loss thereof, from any cause whatever.

6. It is mutually agreed that this contract shall continue for the term of six (6) years, provided the second party shall continue and remain in business for that length of time; but the first party shall have the right to terminate said agency upon the failure of the second party to comply with any term or condition of this contract. Said first party shall also have the right to terminate this contract in the event that the contract between the State and any of said publishers shall be terminated for any cause, or in the event that the party of the first part shall cease to be said State Depository and either party shall have the right to terminate same upon thirty (30) days' notice in writing, with or without cause.

7. The second party agrees that if he shall fail or refuse to keep in stock a sufficient supply of books and sell them at the contract prices, and if on account of such failure or refusal the party of the first part should be required to pay any of the penalties provided for in said contracts between the party of the first part and said publishers, or between said publishers and the State of Alabama, or if the party of the first part should thereby sustain any other loss or damage, then the second party agrees to pay the amount of such penalties or other loss or damage sustained by the party of the first part and to hold harmless the first party against any loss, liability or damage whatever by reason of such defaults of the party of the second part.

8. IT IS FURTHER AGREED by the parties hereto, that the amount of stock which may be returned by the party of the second part at the expiration of this contract, and for which party of the first part shall give the second party credit, shall not exceed twenty (20%) per cent. of the amount of sales of such book reported to party of the first part during the preceding twelve (12) months, and any excess of 20% shall be paid for by second party the same as if same had been sold.

9. Final settlement shall be made and all books returned to first party F. O. B. Birmingham, Alabama, case and cartage paid, and all moneys due shall be paid immediately upon termination of contract.

10. The second party agrees, within ten days from the date hereof, to furnish first party a bond, with a surety company approved by first party as surety, in the sum of \$1,000, conditioned for the faithful performance of each and all of the obligations of the second party, under this contract. Suit for enforcement of any obligation or liability under this contract may be brought against principal and sureties on said bond in the Circuit Court of Jefferson County, Alabama, at Birmingham.

11. The right of exemption is hereby waived as provided in Constitution and Laws of the State of Alabama, or any other State in the United States, and it is further agreed that the undersigned second party shall pay all costs of collection for the enforcement of any of the terms or provisions of this contract, including a reasonable attorney's fee.

An itemized statement of the account, verified by the affidavit of a competent witness, is filed with the original summons and complaint in this cause.

(4) Plaintiff claims of the defendant One Hundred Ninety-five and 30/100 (\$195.30) Dollars, damages for the breach of an agreement entered into by him on the 1st day of July, 1933, a true and correct copy of which agreement is hereto attached and made a part hereof, the same as if set out in full; plaintiff avers that under and by the terms of said agreement it furnished to the defendant merchandise of the value of One Hundred Ninety-five and 30/100 (\$195.30) Dollars, that it

has not received payment for said merchandise and that the sum of One Hundred Ninety-Five and 30/100 (\$195.30) Dollars, with interest thereon, is due and still unpaid, hence this suit.
