The condition of the above obligation is such that, on the 4th day of May, 1934, J. B. Huckabee, a Justice of the Peace in and for said County, rendered a judgment in favor of the said Mack Shelby against the said B. T. Hudson, for the possession of nineteen (19) cypress logs and \$12.75 costs, from which said judgment the said B. T. Hudson has applied for and obtained an appeal to the Circuit Court of Baldwin County; if the said B. T. Hudson shall prosecute said appeal to effect, or if he fail in said appeal, shall pay and perform such judgment as may be rendered against him by the said Circuit Court of Baldwin County, then in either of said events, this obligation to be void otherwise to remain in full force and effect.
