COMPLAINT

The plaintiff claims of the defendant the sum of TWO HUNDRED SEVENTY TWO & 87/100 (\$272.87) DOLLARS, together with the interest thereon from August 1st, 1932, as damages for that, on or about the fifteenth day of June 1932, the plaintiff and defendant entered into a verbal contract by which it was agreed that the plaintiff and defendant would engage in the business of buying and selling sweet potatoes, at Foley, Alabama, during the sweet potato crop season in the year 1932.

It was agreed between the parties that the plaintiff should buy, grade, pack and prepare for shipment and sale such sweet potatoes and that the defendant would attend to the marketing and sale of such sweet potatoes and that the profits or losses of such venture would be divided equally between plaintiff and defendant.

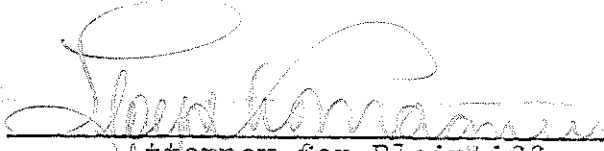
Acting upon such contract and agreement the plaintiff purchased a total of six carloads of sweet potatoes for which the plaintiff paid, including the cost of grading, sorting and packing and including the cost of the containers in which said sweet potatoes were shipped, the total price of FOURTEEN HUNDRED NINETY-FIVE & 74/100 (\$1,495.74) DOLLARS.

Acting upon said agreement the defendant arranged to market said potatoes with one Sam Pasekoff, a produce broker in Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania and acting upon the instructions of the defendant so to do, the plaintiff shipped said sweet potatoes to the said Sam Pasekoff who sold the same and accounted to the plaintiff for the proceeds, and advanced to the plaintiff in money upon said six carloads of sweet potatoes, a total of NINE HUNDRED AND FIFTY & 00/100 (\$950.00) DOLLARS.

Said sweet potatoes were sold by the said Sam Pasekoff for the total gross price of TWO THOUSAND ONE HUNDRED AND SEVENTY FIVE & 03/100 (\$2,175.03) DOLLARS and the expenses upon said six carloads of sweet potatoes for freight, terminal charges, demurrage, brokerage, etc., amounted to the total sum of THIRTEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-ONE AND 04/100 (\$1,331.04) DOLLARS so that the said Sam Pasekoff received as the net proceeds of the sale of said six carloads of sweet potatoes the sum of EIGHT HUNDRED FORTY THREE & 99/100 (\$843.99) DOLLARS, being less than the amount of his advances so that all of the money which plaintiff received for said six carloads of sweet potatoes was the advances made by the said Sam Pasekoff as aforesaid, being the sum of NINE HUNDRED & 50/100 (\$950.00) DOLLARS, and the plaintiff lost the difference between what he paid for said sweet potatoes, to-wit: the sum of ONE THOUSAND FOUR HUNDRED NINETY FIVE & 74/100 (\$1,495.74) DOLLARS and said advances, or the sum of FIVE HUNDRED FORTY-FIVE & 74/100 (\$545.74) DOLLARS.

That by the terms of the said verbal agreement between the plaintiff and defendant, any losses incurred were to be paid equally by the plaintiff and defendant but although plaintiff has many times demanded of the defendant that he

pay to the plaintiff one-half of said loss and damage, in
the amount of TWO HUNDRED SEVENTY TWO & 87/100 (\$272.87)
DOLLARS the defendant has failed and refused to pay to
the plaintiff any part of such loss and damage, wherefore
plaintiff sues.
