COUNT ONE.

The Plaintiff claims of the defendant the sum of ONE THOUSAND & 00/100 (\$1,000.00) DOLLARS, due by a promissory note made by him on the first day of March, 1931, and payable on the first day of March, 1932, payable to Ed. Doscher and endorsed to the Plaintiff, together with the interest thereon.

COUNT TWO.

The Plaintiff claims of the defendant the further sum of ONE HUNDRED TWENTY SEVEN & 80/100 (\$127.80) DOLLARS, due by a promissory note made by him on the first day of June, 1934 and payable on the first day of August, 1934, payable to Eda Doscher and by her endorsed to the plaintiff, together with the interest thereon.

The plaintiff avers that in, by and as a part of the note sued on in Count One hereof, the defendant agreed to pay all costs of collecting, securing or attempting to collect or secure said debt, including a reasonable attorney's fee, and the plaintiff avers that the sum of ONE HUNDRED FIFTY & 00/100 (\$150.00) DOLLARS is such reasonable attorney's fee and the plaintiff claims of the defendant the further and additional sum of ONE HUNDRED FIFTY & 00/100 (\$150.00) DOLLARS as such attorney's fee.

COUNT SIX.

The plaintiff avers that in, by and as a part of the note sued on in Count Two hereof, the defendant agreed to pay all costs of collecting, securing or attempting to collect or secure said debt, including a reasonable attorney's fee, and the plaintiff avers that the sum of TWENTY FIVE & 00/100 (\$25.00) DOLLARS is such reasonable attorney's fee and the plaintiff claims of the Defendant the further and additional sum of TWENTY FIVE & 00/100 (\$25.00) DOLLARS as such attorney's fee.

That all of said sums are due and unpaid, wherefor Plaintiff
sues.
