To the FOURTH interrogatory, he says:-

I had a large amount of correspondence with B. and H. Nurseries of Three Rivers, Michigan in the fall of 1929, which resulted in my selling them an order of trees, amounting to upwards of \$1700.00.

To the FIFTH interrogatory, he says:-

B. & H. Nurseries was a copartnership composed of William B. Burmeister and A. J. Hartung.

To the SIXTH interrogatory, he says:-

William B. Burmeister and A. J. Hartung were copartners, doing business under the trade name of "B. & H. Nurseries" and in the fall of 1929, I sold them an order of trees amounting to something upwards of \$1700.00. Later on, they gave their note for the amount of their purchase and that note has been renewed once or twice and nothing has been paid on it, other than interest.

To the SEVENTH interrogatory, he says:-

My sale of nursery stock to William B. Burmeister and A. J. Harting, doing business at Three Rivers, Michigan, under the trade name of "B. & H. Nurseries" was not on or about the 11th day of Oxtober 1930. The sale was completed by correspondence during the previous fall and winter and the stock was delivered in March and April 1930. James A. Kelly of Dansville, N. Y. is sole owner and proprietor of Kelly Brothers Nurseries.

To the FOURTH interrogatory, he says:-

I know the defendants, William B. Burmeister and A. J. Hartung. I called upon them several times at their place of business at Three Rivers, Michigan and have had considerable correspondence with them in the last ten years. In a business way, I am well acquainted with both of them.
