It is further ordered, adjudged and decreed that Complainant herein shall have the right to resume the use of her maiden name, Addie Louise Bishop.

It is further ordered, adjudged and decreed that neither party to this suit shall again marry except to each other until sixty days after the rendition of this decree, and that if appeal is taken within sixty days, neither party shall again marry except to each other during the pendency of said appeal.

It is further ordered that the Complainant and Respondent be, and they are hereby permitted to again contract marriage upon the payment of the cost of this suit.

It is further ordered that _____ the Respondent pay the cost herein to be taxed, for which execution may issue.

(whose maiden name was Addie Louise Bishop and)


First: Complainant, who is 20 years of age, and Respondent, who is 27

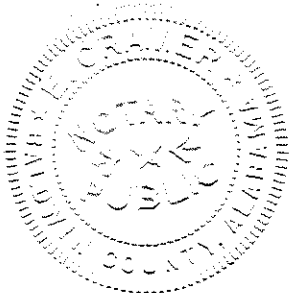
