First: Complainant,/who is 20 years of age, and Respondent, who is 27 years of age, intermarried May 16th 1945.

Second: Both parties hereto have resided in Fairhope, Alabama, since before said marriage.

Third: The parties hereto, because of the acts herein complained of, are not presently living together. While they were living together, said McNoland Bush, on several occasions, committed acts of violence upon the the person of complainant attended with danger to her life and health and, by his conduct, there is reasonable apprehension that he will again commit such violence.

The premises considered, Complainant prays that said McNoland Bush be, by appropriate process, made party defendant hereto, that he be compelled to plead, demur or enswer to the within Bill of Complaint within the time prescribed by law and that he be required to obey ail orders and decrees med in the premises.

Further, Complainant prays, upon a hearing of the within cause, that a decree be granted divorcing her forever from said Respondent; giving her the right to resume the use of her maiden name, Addie Louise Bishop, and granting her such other, further and different relief as to Your Honor may seem meet and proper.
