Sealed with our seals and dated this 29th day of October, 1934.

The condition of the above obligation is such that, on the 25th day of October, 1934, G. E. Perkin, a Justice of the Peace, in and for said County, rendered a judgment in favor of the said Jackson Grace against said Jim Jimison, for the recovery of certain lands described in the cause of Jackson Grace vs. Jim Jimison, in said Justice Court, to-wit:

Beginning at Northeast corner of South half of Southwest quarter of Section 21, Township 5 South of Range 2 East, thence run West 3.16 chains, thence South 6.32 chains, thence East 3.16 chains, thence North 6.32 chains to point of beginning, containing 2 acres in Section 21, Township 5 South of Range 2 East, Baldwin County, Alabama,
