Now comes the Employers Insurance Company of
Alabama, Inc., a corporation, duly organized and existing under
the laws of the State of Alabama, having its homeoffice in the
City of Birmingham, Alabama, and respectfully represents and
shows unto this Honorable Court as follows:

Your petitioner shows that Mrs. Mattie Sibley,
a widow, the mother of Louis Sibley, deceased, is a bona-fide
resident of Stapleton, Baldwin County, Alabama.

Your petitioner shows that it carries the
Workmens' Compensation Insurance on the employees of the State
of Alabama, and that the above named decedent was killed several
months ago while working for the State Highway Department of the
State of Alabama, and death was caused to said employee by an
accident arising out of and in the course of his employment.


Your petitioner further shows that at the time
of the death of the said decedent, his average weekly wage was
Eleven and 50/100 (\$11.50) Dollars, and that the mother of said
decedent has agreed to accept the sum of Two and 87/100 (\$2.87)
Dollars per week for Three Hundred (300) weeks as compensation
by way of damages for the death of her said son, Louis Sibley,
deceased.

Your petitioner further shows that the agreement
between the said Mrs. Mattie Sibley, a widow, and your petitioner,
relative to the said compensation is in writing, having been duly
executed in Stapleton, Baldwin County, Alabama, on the 15th day
of March, 1935, and that the original of said agreement is hereto
attached, and made a part hereof as if the same were completely
written and incorporated in this petition.

Your petitioner further shows that in accordance

with the said agreement, it has been paying compensation to the said Mrs. Mattie Sibley at the rate stipulated in said agreement since the date of its execution and has paid her all compensation at the same rate which was due from the date of the death of the said Louis Sibley, deceased, to the date of the execution of the agreement.

Your petitioner therefore prays that your Honor will approve said agreement according to law as in such cases made and provided, and in duty bound, your petitioner will ever pray.

This agreement made and entered into on this the 15 day of March, 1935, by and between Mattie Sibley, ^{a widow} the mother of Louis Sibley, deceased, and the Employer's Insurance Company of Alabama, Inc., WITNESSETH,

WHEREAS, Louis Sibley, while working in the State Highway Department of the State of Alabama, was killed in the performance of his duties some time ago.

It is hereby distinctly understood and agreed by and between the parties to this instrument, that the said Mattie Sibley, hereby agrees to accept the 2.87 per week for three hundred (300) weeks, as compensation to her arising out of the death of the said Louis Sibley.
