The defendant, in and by said note, waives as to this debt or any renewal thereof, all right to exemption under the Constitution and laws of Alabama, or any other state, as to personal

property, and agrees to pay all cost of collecting or securing, or attempting to collect or secure this note, including a reasonable attorneys' fee, whether the same be collected or secured by suit or otherwise; and the plaintiff claims the benefit of said waiver.

And the plaintiff claims the further and additional sum of TWENTY-FIVE DOLLARS (\$25.00) as a reasonable attorneys' fee in the premises.
