



Count 1. The plaintiff claims of the defendant the sum of One Hundred Forty-two Dollars (\$142.00, due from the defendant under the Revenue Laws of the State of Alabama for a corporation franchise tax amounting to One Hundred Twelve Dollars (\$112.00) for the tax year beginning January 1, 1935, and a corporation permit fee of Thirty Dollars (\$30.00) for the calendar year 1935; and the further sum of One Percent (1%) per month from May 1, 1935 of said franchise tax and interest thereon at the legal rate from said date, and interest at the legal rate from January 1, 1935 on said permit fee, for the failure or refusal of the defendant to pay said amounts herein claimed, - which sums of money are due and unpaid.

The plaintiff claims for the payment of said sums and the costs of this suit a lien superior to all other liens upon all of the goods, wares and merchandise or any other property owned by the defendant and prays for process and judgment for the preservation and enforcement of said lien.
