

ANSWER OF GARNISHEE.

Now comes E. S. Tunstall, Tax Assessor of Baldwin County, Alabama, Garnishee, in the above stated cause and for answer to the Writ of Garnishment served upon him on the 27th day of July, 1935, upon oath says: That he was not indebted to the above named Defendant at the time of service of the garnishment in the above stated cause or at the time of making his answer thereto; that he will not be indebted in future to the said Defendant by a contract then existing or at the time of the service of this summons except as will hereinafter appear, and that he has not in his possession or under his control personal or real property or things in action, belonging to the said A. R. Cromartie except that the said Defendant, A. R. Cromartie is now temporarily employed by E. S. Tunstall, as Tax Assessor of Baldwin County, Alabama, at a monthly salary of sixty dollars (\$60.00) per month but the said A. R. Cromartie is indebted to the said E. S. Tunstall in the sum of two hundred and forty dollars (\$240.00), and the amount due him for his services has been credited by the said E. S. Tunstall on the indebtedness due him, and this practice will continue until the said indebtedness is paid in full.

The Garnishee having fully answered, prays to be discharged with his reasonable costs in this behalf expended.

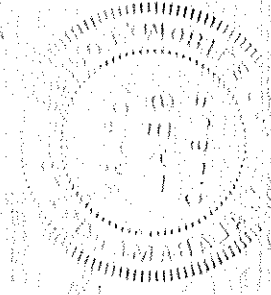
