Before me, the undersigned commissioner, acting by agreement of parties, personally appeared this day WILVER LANGHAM and MRS. NETTIE MAE LANGHAM, who, being sworn, upon examination testified as follows:

WILVER LANGHAM

My name is WILVER LANGHAM and I am the Complainant in this, divorce action against ADDIE LOIS STORY LANGHAM. Iam twenty—years of age and my wife is eighteen years of age. I was born and raised in Baldwin County and have lived here all of my life, except when I was in the Navy. While in the Service and on the 10th of July, 1945, I married ADDIE LOIS STORY LANGHAM in Greenville, County, Virginia and we lived together as husband and wife until about the 19th day of September, 1945. During this time my wife and I were together whenever I got shore leave. In September, 1945, while I was over-seas, I received word from my wife telling me that my home was broken up and that she did not want me to come back; and I attach the letter which I received from my wife to my testimony and mark it Exhibit "A", for identification.
