Your Complainant, FEARN LORRAINE RAMSEY, respectfully shows unto your Honor that she is, and has been for more than two years next preceding the filing of the Bill of Complaint, a bona fide resident citizen of the State of Alabama, residing at Bay Minette, Baldwin County, Alabama; that she is over the age of twenty-one years; and humbly complaining against the Respondent, your Complainant shows unto your Honor the following facts as a basis for the relief hereinafter prayed:

1. That the Respondent, BENNIE OLIVER RAMSEY is a resident of the State of Alabama, residing at Mobile, Mobile

County, Alabama; that the said Respondent is over the age of twenty-

- 2. That your Complainant and the Respondent are husband and wife, having intermarried at Bay Minette, Baldwin County, Alabama, on December 30, 1939; that they lived together as husband wife until, to-wit: April 12, 1943, in Bay Minette, Baldwin County, Alabama;
- 3. That on, to-wit: April 12, 1943, the Respondent voluntarily, and without cause or justification, abandoned your Complainant and has since that time refused to live with her as her husband; that said Respondent has not contributed to your Complainant's support since that time;
- h. That your Complainant and the Respondent have one child, a female, named CAROLYN JOYCE RAMSEY, age five years; that since the Respondent abandoned your Complainant, your Complainant has supported and maintained the said child; that your Complainant is a fit and proper person to have the custody and control of said child; that the Respondent is not a fit and proper person to have the custody and control of said child.

WHEREFORE, the premises considered, your Complainant prays that this Honorable Court will take jurisdiction of the cause made by this Bill of Complaint; and that by proper process the said BENNIE OLIVER RAMSEY BE made a party defendant hereto, requiring him to plead, answer or demur to the same within the time and under the pains and penalties prescribed by law and the practice of this Honorable Court.
